

## Nuclear Pharmacy Professional Development Program

Dear Board Certified Nuclear Pharmacist:

Beginning Friday, January 1, 2016, Purdue University College of Pharmacy will assume responsibility as the BPS Professional Development Provider for the recertification of Board Certified Nuclear Pharmacists (BCNP).

BPS wishes to thank the University of New Mexico (UNM) College of Pharmacy and in particular the leadership of Kristina Wittstrom, PhD, BCNP and the support of Christina Muñoz, MA in administering this recertification program. For more than 15 years, nearly all Board Certified Nuclear Pharmacists have used the UNM program for recertification.

As this transition occurs, please note that **all recertification credit requests must be submitted to the University of New Mexico by Thursday, December 31, 2015 in order to process credit earned towards your BCNP recertification.** Credit from the University of New Mexico for BCNP recertification will not be accepted after Thursday, December 31, 2015, although pharmacists may utilize credits earned after the above date for general continuing pharmacy education purposes.

For BCNPs due to recertify in 2015, BPS will send a more detailed communication to you in the next few weeks. In addition, information regarding the recertification program and offerings to be provided by Purdue University will be available in the Fall.
