Reporting CPE

We do not provide a hard copy of certificates. All CE hours will be reported monthly through CPE Monitor as required by the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (https://www.acpe-accredit.org/) as of January 1, 2013. You will be required to provide us with your NABP ePID# and MM/DD at the time of CPE event, with-out this information your CE hours will not below on how to obtain a number.

Nuclear Specific

Hours will be reported automatically at the beginning of each month (unless it falls on a holiday break or weekend).

All other CPE programs

It is your responsibility to apply for credit after your event has taken place at the following URL: https://unmpharmacyce.org/user/login. You must complete an evaluation online in order to receive CPE credit. CPE Monitor is a collaborative service from The National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP) and Accreditation Council of Pharmacy Education (ACPE) that provides an electronic system for pharmacists and pharmacy technicians to track their completed CPE credits. It also streamlines reporting and compliance verification for participating boards of pharmacy.

NABP ePID: What is it and why do I need it?

Your NABP e-Profile ID is a permanent identification number that you need in order to receive credit for any ACPE-accredited continuing pharmacy education (CPE) programs. CPE providers will ask you to provide the e-Profile ID either when registering for CPE or when submitting participation data to the provider. Please note that currently the e-Profile ID is not required for non-ACPE accredited CPE; however, this feature will be added in the future. The NABP has extensive amounts of information available on their website (http://www.nabp.net/) explaining the program and the e-PIN registration process.
